## Update on the Biosecurity Surveillance Strategy

*The Biosecurity Surveillance Group is developing a strategy for a cross-sector national biosecurity surveillance system that will set the direction for New Zealand's future biosecurity surveillance activities.*

We have recently finished collecting feedback from a key reference group comprised of people and organisations that undertake a variety of roles in biosecurity surveillance, across many industries and sectors. We are now in the process of reviewing that feedback, and have found it very useful – improving the document and framing our thinking about the future. Many organisations submitted comments that captured similar concepts or raised similar points for consideration. We will continue to analyse the feedback and update the draft Review of the Current State of Biosecurity Surveillance. The current intent is that this document will be released more widely in 2008, when we undertake public consultation on our strategy for the future.

Early development of part two of the Biosecurity Surveillance strategy (tentatively titled "Vision, principles and approaches for the future biosecurity surveillance system") has commenced. We've developed a scope for the document, and have started undertaking research in various areas to help provide some foundations for the document. Development of the framework of this section of the strategy is underway.

We're committed to keeping you up to date with progress, and are looking forward to contact with many of you in coming months, as we start working on the strategy for the future of Biosecurity Surveillance in New Zealand.
