

UNAUTHORISED OPENING OF UNACCOMPANIED PERSONAL EFFECTS IS PROHIBITED

The importer / importer's agent acknowledges that:

- 1.** Unaccompanied personal effects must not be opened without MAF Quarantine Service authorisation. This includes the container, crates and any boxes / packages.
- 2.** It is the responsibility of the importer or agent applying for the clearance of goods to ensure the directions for delivery and inspection as shown on the Unaccompanied Personal Baggage Declaration (issued in accordance with the Biosecurity Act 1993) are followed. If inspection is required an inspection date and time with MAF Quarantine Service will be arranged by visiting or telephoning the local MAF Quarantine Service office.
- 3.** Should any details on the Unaccompanied Personal Baggage Declaration require alteration, including the location of the inspection, the Declaration is to be returned to MAF Quarantine Service for updating.
- 4.** Failure to comply with directions on the Unaccompanied Personal Baggage Declaration may result in legal action pursuant to the Biosecurity Act 1993.
