

MAF Biosecurity New Zealand In-flight Video

This is an important notice about New Zealand law.

You must declare on this Passenger Arrival Card if you are carrying

any food including fruit and vegetables, any meat, fish and poultry, ingredients used in cooking and all dairy products – this includes anything you can cook, eat or swallow.

Also declare any plants, wooden items, seeds, animal products, traditional or herbal medicines, outdoor or sports equipment, or any related products. Declare them on your Passenger Arrival Card and we may inspect them.

Or dispose of them in the amnesty bins located throughout our airports, or, if you not sure, ask us.

Any of these bags, including your bags, could be carrying pests and diseases that can harm the New Zealand environment.

Our detector dogs are trained to find restricted items.

Your bags will be X-rayed or inspected.

If you fail to declare for any reason

You can be fined a minimum of two hundred dollars, up to one hundred thousand dollars, or you may face imprisonment.

Don't forget to declare or dispose. It is New Zealand law.
