## CTO direction to biosecurity inspectors for the clearance of emu oil from Australia

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Vicki Melville, Manager Animal Imports, Ministry for Primary Industries (under delegated authority), give the following directions for emu oil from Australia to be given clearance in accordance with the following measures, different from those in the applicable import health standard for the importation of emu oil into New Zealand from Australia, (EMUOILIC.AUS)

Clause 8.3 specifies that the consignment must be accompanied by an appropriately completed original documentation, but this direction allows copies to be used in place of the original documents.

The reason for directing clearance is that the biosecurity risks associated with this CTO direction have been assessed and are managed effectively.

This direction takes effect from the date of signing and continues in effect until amended or revoked.
