To Exporters of forest products, and ISPM 15 mark applicators:

Biosecurity New Zealand use of direct charging from 1 July 2007.

Biosecurity New Zealand services will be directly charged at the hourly rates specified in "Biosecurity New Zealand fees and charges from 1 July 2007" and available from http://www.biosecurity.govt.nz/commercial-exports/foestry-exports/fees.

The services directly charged are:

- incident management or advice to individual technical service providers or exporters;
- negotiating equivalences to overseas market access requirements;
- updating registers on request;
- revoking recognitions and approvals when necessary;
- reviewing approved systems on request; and
- issuance of replacement certification and official assurances.
