## Forestry in the Emissions Trading Scheme – post-1989

### How to submit your application

1. Log-in to Tupu-ake – Forestry ETS online services, available at [www.mpi.govt.nz/ets-online-system/](http://www.mpi.govt.nz/ets-online-system/)
2. Select the service **Post-1989 forest land (standard) > Apply to join or leave the ETS > Apply to deregister.**
3. Upload the completed form to the file upload on the main summary page.

### Next steps

We will process your application and contact you about the outcome.

When you deregister from the ETS, you must pay (surrender) the unit balance of your carbon accounting areas to the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA). The EPA will contact you with instructions and how many New Zealand Units you must pay.
