



**CTO Direction to MPI Inspector**  
**Biosecurity clearance of non-compliant consignment/s**

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, , give the following directions for consignments of *Pinus* species imported from a country not listed as free from *Fusarium circinatum*, to be given biosecurity clearance in accordance with the following measures, different from those required by section 3.1.3 in the import health standard (IHS) *Poles, piles, rounds and sleepers from all countries*:

- Evidence of treatment at a core temperature of 56°C for 1 hour to mitigate the risk of *Fusarium circinatum*.
- Evidence has been supplied for consignment C2016/148470 that it has been treated to at least 56°C for 1 hour and can be regarded as having freedom from *Fusarium circinatum*.

All other relevant sections of the IHS *Poles, piles, rounds and sleepers from all countries* for *Pinus sp.* wood must be complied with.

This direction takes effect from the date of signing, and may apply to multiple consignments of *Pinus sp* wood which are not compliant with the measures required by section 3.1.3 in the import health standard (IHS) *Poles, piles, rounds and sleepers from all countries*. This CTO direction is valid until 2 June 2018 at which stage it must be reviewed, unless it is amended or revoked.
