Equivalent measures for consignments non-compliant with VEHICLE-ALL

CTO direction code for recording in Quantum: CTO Plants: 2017 0005

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Peter Thomson, give the following directions for measures, different from those required by section 4.3 in the Import Health Standard (IHS): *Vehicles, Machinery and Tyres* – VEHICLE-ALL, that may be applied to consignments of vehicles and machinery for the management of the risk of the Brown Marmorated Stink Bug.

Treatment with:

Sulfuryl fluoride at 16g/m3 for 12 hours with a minimum dose reading of 8 g/m³ at a temperature of 10°C or greater to achieve a CT of 144 g.h/m³.

All other relevant sections of the IHS: VEHICLE-ALL for vehicles and machinery must be complied with.

This direction takes effect from the 8 February 2017, and may apply to multiple consignments of vehicles and machinery which are not compliant with the measures required by section 4.3 in the IHS: VEHICLE-ALL. This CTO direction is valid for 2 years from the date of signing unless earlier amended or revoked.
