

This schedule of special entry conditions for fresh *Citrus sinensis* (oranges) from Spain has been suspended dated 05 September 2019.

***Citrus sinensis* (oranges) from Spain is not eligible for import into New Zealand.**

A MPI Chief Technical Officer believes that on the basis of new technical information, the treatment rates used for the fruit fly *Ceratitis capitata* on this pathway no longer manage the biosecurity risk to an appropriate level and, therefore, does not enable the purposes of the Biosecurity Act 1993 (Part 3) to be achieved.

MPI is currently undertaking a review of all citrus Import Health Standards.
