



**CTO Direction**

**Equivalent measures for consignments non-compliant with VEHICLE-ALL**

**CTO direction code for recording in Quantum: CTO Plants: 20170038**

Pursuant to section 27(1) (d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Paul Hallett, give the following directions for measures, different from those required by section 4.3 in the import health standard (IHS): *Vehicles, Machinery and Tyres* – VEHICLE-ALL, that may be applied to consignments of vehicles and machinery sourced from the United States of America (USA): Treatment with:

- Sulfuryl fluoride fumigation at 16 g/m<sup>3</sup> for 12 hours at 10°C or greater with a 50% end point reading with a maximum post-treatment storage period of 96 hours.

All other relevant sections of the IHS: VEHICLE-ALL for vehicles and machinery sourced from the USA must be complied with.

This direction takes effect from the 19 December 2017, and may apply to multiple consignments of vehicles and machinery sourced from the USA which are not compliant with the measures required by section 4.3 in the import health standard (IHS) VEHICLE-ALL. This CTO direction is valid for one year from the date of signing unless earlier amended or revoked.
