NZ Delegation Report of the 51st session of CCPR

Major outcomes of the 51st session of CCPR of interest to New Zealand are as follows:

- Progressed a large number of MRLs for endorsement by the CAC. these include a number of compounds of interest to New Zealand;
- The committee progressed work in revising the classification of Primary Feed Commodities of Plant Origin (forages, hays/straws and grasses); Processed Food Commodities of Plant Origin (dried fruit, dried vegetables, dried herbs, milled cereal products, roasted beans, teas, juices, etc.);
- The committee considered opportunities to harmonise animal commodity grouping with CCRVDF;
- The review of the IESTI equations continues including completing the document on advantages and challenges of the existing IESTI equations;
- The committee could not reach consensus any of the options proposed on how to address the management of unsupported compounds. It was agreed to establish an EWG to investigate the circumstances that lead to unsupported compounds and obstacles that prevent providing support and explore the advantages and challenges that arise from the options proposed in the paper;
- The committee agreed to establish an EWG to develop a guidance document on establishing criteria for exempting compounds from establishing Codex MRLs where they are of low public health concern (focus on biopesticides).
