### Notes:

- (1) These rates include \$0.025 per lamb equivalent collected on behalf of the Meat Industry Association, in addition to the recovery of MPI costs.
- (2) Note that prior to 1 July 2018, there was a partial waiver in place for deer which resulted in charges of \$0.86 per head for export premises and \$0.10 per head for domestic premises. Therefore the changes have resulted in increases in levies for processing deer.
- (3) As applied to large processors and exporters; there is no change in the rates for small and medium processors and small exporters.
