Pet Food: Dehydrated by Refrigeration

CTO direction to biosecurity inspectors for the clearance of pet food dehydrated by refrigeration

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Nasser Ahmed, Senior Adviser (Animal Imports), Ministry for Primary Industries (under delegated authority), give direction for pet food dehydrated by refrigeration to be given clearance in accordance with the following measures, different from those in the *Import Health Standard for Shelf-stable Petfoods Containing Animal Products (PETFODIC.ALL;1 May 2007)*:

Clauses 7.4 (i), 7.5(i) and 7.6(i): The product has been cooked by baking, or cooked during the process of extrusion, **or dehydrated by refrigeration.**
