CTO direction to biosecurity inspectors for the clearance of New Zealand-origin smoked salmon

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Nasser Ahmed, Senior Adviser (Animal Imports), Ministry for Primary Industries (under delegated authority), give direction for the following consignment to be given clearance in accordance with the assessment of equivalence to the import health standard *Importing Salmonids for Human Consumption from Australia (FISSALIC.AUS, 16 August 2000)*

Consignment

- Consignment pertaining to MPI's Permit to Import 2013051767 only; must not be applied to other consignments or import permits
- Consignment comprising of New Zealand-origin salmon processed into cold smoke salmon slices, cold smoke salmon shavings, hot smoke salmon portions, raw salmon trimmings in the Philippines and returned to New Zealand for retail sale.
