EDIPROIC: Original Documents

CTO direction to biosecurity inspectors for the clearance of specified foods containing animal products.

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Vicki Melville, Manager Animal Imports, Ministry for Primary Industries (under delegated authority), give the following directions for specified foods containing animal products to be given clearance in accordance with the following measures, different from those in the applicable import health standard Specified Foods for Human Consumption Containing Animal Products EDIPROIC.ALL:

Copies of certificates and declarations are acceptable substitutes for originals when presenting evidence for clearance of shipments of products.

Biosecurity risks are managed effectively through the IHS.

The reason for directing clearance is that the biosecurity risks associated with this CTO direction have been assessed and are managed effectively.

This direction takes effect from the date of signing and continues in effect until amended or revoked.
