## **NOTICE UNDER THE BIOSECURITY ACT 1993**

# SECTION 131 - DECLARATION OF CONTROLLED AREA AND NOTICE OF MOVEMENT CONTROLS AND PROCEDURES IN RESPECT OF QUEENSLAND FRUIT FLY (QFF) - Bactrocera tryoni

#### Commencement

1. This Declaration and Notice takes effect at 11:15am on 18 February 2019.

## Revocation of previous Declaration of Controlled Area and Notice of Movement Controls

 This Declaration and Notice revokes and replaces the Declaration of Controlled Area and Notice of Movement Controls issued at 2.00pm on 17 February 2019 in respect of Queensland Fruit Fly (QFF) detected in Devonport, Auckland.

#### Controlled Area Declaration

- 3. Pursuant to section 131(2) of the Biosecurity Act 1993, I hereby declare that the area described in Schedule 1 ("the Controlled Area") is the area that is controlled in order to:
  - a. Enable the limitation of the spread of QFF, being an unwanted organism under the Biosecurity Act 1993;
  - b. Minimise the damage caused by QFF;
  - c. Protect New Zealand from an incursion of QFF;
  - d. Facilitate the access of New Zealand products to overseas markets; and
  - e. Monitor risks associated with the movement of QFF from parts of New Zealand where the QFF status is unknown.

## **Notice of Movement Controls**

- 4. Under section 131(3)(a) of the Biosecurity Act 1993, I hereby give notice that, except with the written permission of an inspector or authorised person appointed under s 103 of the Biosecurity Act 1993, and in compliance with any conditions imposed by an inspector or authorised person
  - a. Things listed in Schedule 3 that are in Controlled Area Zone A must not be moved outside Zone A: and
  - b. Things listed in Schedule 3 that are in the Controlled Area Zone B must not be moved outside Zone B; and
  - c. Things listed in Schedule 3 that are in Controlled Area Zones A or B must not be disposed of by putting out for collection by rubbish or recycling collectors.
- 5. Things listed in Schedule 3 may be moved into Controlled Area Zones A and B.

## **Schedule 1 Description of Controlled Area**

The following areas are included in the Controlled Area and subject to this Notice:

#### Zone A

Controlled Area (Zone A) is the area within a 200 metre radius of a point in Rattray Street, Devonport, Auckland, but excluding that part of the New World Devonport car park east of Bartley Terrace and south of Fleet Street, and southeast through the alleyway behind New Zealand post to Devon lane and southwest on Devon lane until bisecting the 200m radius, at the south-western boundary of the Controlled Area (Zone A), as defined in the map in Schedule 2.

#### Zone B

Controlled Area (Zone B) is the area which has the boundaries listed below, and is defined in the map in Schedule 2

Description of boundaries of Controlled Area (Zone B)

- 1. Beginning at the intersection of Wairoa Rd and Vauxhall Rd, heading in a straight line in a north-easterly direction toward the Auckland harbour mean high water mark ("the shoreline") and proceeding 200m out to sea from the shoreline; then
- 2. Turning and continuing in a south-easterly direction, following a line 200m out to sea from the shoreline at all times, toward Takapuna Head, to North Head, going around North Head; then
- 3. Continuing in a westerly direction past the Devonport Ferry terminal and the Devonport Naval Base, encompassing all jetties, piers and wharfs; then
- 4. Turning and heading in a northerly direction towards the Stanley Point Ferry Terminal, turning west to encompass the Stanley Point Ferry Terminal and all jetties, piers and wharfs; then
- 5. Continuing west at sea until level with the part of Stanley Point Rd with bus stops 1 and 2, then heading back to shore to those bus stops; then
- 6. Heading in a north-easterly direction across Stanley Point Rd to Stanley Bay Park and following the eastern boundary of Stanley Bay Park until it meets Ngataringa Bay Sports field; then
- 7. Following the southern boundary of Ngataringa Bay Sports field, then heading north along the eastern boundary of Ngataringa Bay Sports field and crossing the laneway of the Sea Safety training squadron into the estuary; then
- 8. Crossing the estuary to the north side in a north-easterly direction, and following the shoreline east until a point opposite the intersection of Seabreeze Road and Lake Rd; then
- Going in a north-easterly direction along Seabreeze Road until the boundary of Woodall Park and turning in a south-easterly direction along the boundary of Woodall Park and Waitemata Golf Club, until Wairoa Rd; then
- 10. Continuing in a northeast direction along Wairoa Rd until the intersection of Wairoa Rd and Vauxhall Rd.

### Specific Properties in Zone A

Where a property is bisected by the boundary of the Controlled Area (Zone A), the entire property shall be included in the Controlled Area (Zone A).

## Specific Properties in Zone B

Where a property is bisected by the boundary of Controlled Area (Zone B), the entire property shall be included in the Controlled Area (Zone B).

## <u>Schedule 3 – Things subject to Movement Controls</u>

## Zone A

- 1. Zone A fruit and vegetables, meaning all whole fruit and vegetables, wherever grown, except for:
  - a. leafy vegetables; and
  - b. root vegetables; and
  - c. cooked, processed, preserved, dried, frozen and canned fruit.
- 2. Packaging materials associated with Zone A fruit and vegetables.
- 3. Soil and planting medium attached to, or in the vicinity of, fruit bearing trees, wherever grown.
- Compost and green waste that contains Zone A fruit and vegetables.

### Zone B

- 1. Zone B fruit and vegetables, meaning all whole fruit and vegetables grown inside Zone B, except for:
  - a. leafy vegetables; and
  - b. root vegetables; and
  - c. cooked, processed, preserved, dried, frozen and canned fruit.
- 2. Packaging materials associated with Zone B fruit and vegetables.
- 3. Soil and planting medium attached to, or in the vicinity of, fruit bearing trees grown inside Zone B.
- 4. Compost and green waste that contains Zone B fruit and vegetables.
