



The *Mycoplasma bovis* (*M. bovis*) eradication Programme can be disruptive and stressful for farmers, families and workers. Support is available so you don't have to go through this alone.

Every farm is different, so we'll aim to put together a unique support package to suit your needs.

Farming through *M. bovis*

- On-farm and phone support: If you're under movement controls, we'll assign you an Incident Control Point (ICP) manager who will visit you regularly and be your main point of contact. If you're under active surveillance, you'll have a dedicated liaison team in the national office, available by phone.
- Information packs are available for all farms undergoing active surveillance, movement controls or depopulation, as well as neighbours of farms that have M. bovis.
- Testing for *M. bovis* is complex and takes time, and takes into account the unique situation on your farm. We've boosted lab resources and recruited additional scientists to help speed up the process. We'll phone you as soon as possible with your test results and we'll follow up in writing.
- We can contribute \$500 (excl GST) to the cost of mustering cattle for testing on farms under active surveillance. Some eligibility criteria apply: www.biosecurity.govt.nz/dmsdocument/32884-paymentsto-muster-cattle-required-for-sampling-criteria-and-howto-apply-factsheet
- Farm recovery plans: Our Recovery Team can help put together a tailored recovery plan for farms under movement controls, when needed.
- We'll contribute up to \$5000 (excl GST) for professional advice for farms that have been depopulated.

Compensation and other financial help

- Operational costs: We can pay for direct costs or damage resulting from the Programme's operational activities, including feed/water in some circumstances. Talk to us first, because these costs need to be authorised in advance.
- We have engaged with banks nationally. With your permission we will talk to your own bank or write letters of assurance to them.
- Inland Revenue provides some tax flexibility and other measures to help. Talk to your accountant as early as possible about this.
