Key Messages

- 1. Submission 18-0156 reports back on progress and achievements since Te Uru Rākau was established as a branded business unit within the Ministry for ,982 (OIA Primary Industries (MPI).
- 2. The Cabinet paper proposes that you report back in early 2020 on Te Uru Rākau's further achievements against the Government's forestry ambitions, including whether its long-term organisational arrangements need to be revisited.
- 3. The Cabinet paper advises that the options of Te Uru Rākau's longer term institutional arrangements are finely balanced. Taking into account the impact of further organisational change on staff, stakeholders and the work programme the paper advises that Te Uru Rakau should continue to scale up as a business unit within the Ministry for Primary Industries.
- Officials consider sufficient and significant progress can be made towards the 4. Government's forestry goals with Te Uru Rākau within its current structure.
- We have submitted a Budget 2019 bid for resources to scale-up Te Uru Rākau 5. by identifying the focus areas and key work programmes towards which proactively Released under the increased capability and capacity would be directed.
