

CTO Direction
Measures for a consignment non-compliant with VEHICLE-ALL

CTO direction code for recording in Quantum: CTO Plants: 20170029

Pursuant to section 27(1) (d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Peter Thomson, give the following direction for measures, different from those required by section 4.3 of the Import Health Standard (IHS): *Vehicles, Machinery and Tyres* – VEHICLE-ALL, that may be applied to manage any biosecurity risks arising from consignment C2017/340674 imported from Indiana, USA:

- Pestigas containing natural pyrethrum and carbon dioxide will be applied by Genera at Auckland Port.
- All possible compartments and doors of the campervan must be opened prior to application and all hidden compartments must be treated;
- The underside of the caravan needs to be sprayed;
- The campervan must remain closed up for 6 hours following treatment;
- An inspection is carried out after treatment by an MPI Inspector;
- All other sections of VEHICLE-ALL IHS must be complied with.

Legal

This direction takes effect from the 27th September 2017 and applies to consignment (C2017/340674) only.
