Cervine Semen to the Republic of Korea (Guidance)

1 Purpose

(1) This guidance document has been issued to accompany *Cervine Semen to the Republic of Korea* (OMAR). This guidance document should be read in conjunction with that OMAR.

2 Specific guidance for the zoosanitary certificate

- (1) In Clause I: Information Concerning the Donor Animal(s) and Semen, the term 'registration number' refers to identification such as ear tag or tattoo.
- (2) With regard to Clause 2.2- Notifiable diseases relevant to deer in accordance with the New Zealand Biosecurity (Notifiable Organisms) Order.
- (3) Clause 3.4 officially free of bovine tuberculosis in accordance with the official control programme for bovine tuberculosis.
- (4) With regard to Clause 3.5 and 3.11- testing is to be performed under the direct supervision of the Centre Veterinarian and either direct or indirect supervision of the Official Veterinarian in accordance with the OIE International Standard Article 4.6.2, (8) and the MPI Official Assurance Programme.
- (5) With regard to Clause 3.9- Despite the term 'isolation' the clause is relative to residency on the semen collection centre after the thirty (30) day pre-entry isolation period has been completed. The sixty (60) day residency on the semen collection centre is in addition to the thirty (30) day pre-entry isolation period.
