The undersigned Official Veterinarian certifies that pet food containing bovine animal products (other than dairy) described above satisfies the following requirements:

Processing, packaging and storage requirements

- (1) to the best of my knowledge, the product for export is:
 - (a.) Produced under condition
 - (a.1) The canned/retorted pet food is packed in hermatically sealed tin/pouch and is sterilized at suitable temperature and time with an F₀>3.0

(a.2) Dry pet food has an A_W at 0.25 to 0.50 and/or

- (b) Stored and subsequently transported in a hygienic manner and kept free of contaminants.
- (c) Clearly identified and the identifier is stated on the certificate.
- (d) Packaged in packaging that is clean, secure and free of any organic contaminants.
- (e) Sealed at the time of manufacture in tamper-proof packaging.

Third country processing

- (2) The animal product was derived from bovine meat that is of New Zealand origin, or that meets the current import requirements of New Zealand.
 - (a) Copies of the original health certificates issued by New Zealand, or copies of the original health certificates meeting New Zealand's import requirements used to import the bovine meat to Thailand, are attched to this certificate.
 - (b) Countries of origin (Australia, Canada, European Union countries, Japan, New Zealand, the USA, Vanuatu);
 - (c) Certificate Numbers:
- (3) The animal product was managed in accordance with the Official Biosecurity Programme agreed between DLD and MPI. Verification processes are in place to ensure approved processing facilities meet the following;
 - (a) Quality management systems are in place to ensure that the animal product is processed, packaged, stored and transported in such a way that prevents cross-contamination.
 - (b) Integrity of product separation from all other products not eligible for export to New Zealand is maintained.
 - (c) Substitution of product is prevented.
 - (d) Traceability of the product, from the eligible country through all processing steps in Thailand until exportation to New Zealand, is maintained.
