



Discuss opportunities with surrounding land owners.




2. Develop strategic plan

Develop plan to reflect the goals and aspirations of the group.




3. Feasibility study

Determine the best use of the land.




4. Getting owners on board

Explain the opportunity to the wider group.




5. Set up governance structure
