CTO direction to biosecurity inspectors for the clearance of zoo waterbuck semen

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Vicki Melville, Manager Animal Imports, Ministry for Primary Industries (under delegated authority), give the following directions for zoo waterbuck semen to be given clearance in accordance with the following measures, different from those in the applicable import health standards; zoo antelope from Australia (zooantic.aus) and the import health standard for bovine semen (bovsemid.gen).

This CTO direction will allow the following:

- 1. The veterinary certificate for zoonantic.aus is not required, as this has been assessed and all risks in the commodity (waterbuck semen) are covered in the bosemic.aus certificate.
- 2. Eligibility /commodity to include frozen waterbuck semen
- 3. Semen collection centres to include:
