

Ref: CTO 2014 127 [G] Zoo: Zebra feed for use during transport

CTO direction to biosecurity inspectors for the clearance of zoo zebras from Australia

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Vicki Melville, Manager Animal Imports, Ministry for Primary Industries (under delegated authority), give the following directions for zoo zebras to be directed into containment in accordance with the following measures, different from those in the applicable import health standard for zoo zebra from Australia (zebaniic.aus):

This CTO direction will allow that the zebra may be accompanied by feed, including hay, for use during transport and during transit. The feed must be treated as biosecurity waste on arrival and meet the requirements of the MPI standard: *General Transitional Facilities for Uncleared Goods Annex O (MPI-STD-TFGEN)*

Biosecurity risks associated with this CTO direction have been assessed and are managed effectively. This is consistent with the import health standard for horses; horaniic.gen.

This direction takes effect from the date of signing and continues in effect until amended or revoked.
