CTO direction to biosecurity inspectors for the clearance of composite products containing more than 5% dairy content.

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Vicki Melville, Manager Animal Imports, Ministry for Primary Industries (under delegated authority), give the following directions for non-shelf stable composite products containing more than 5% dairy to be given clearance in accordance with the following measures, different from those in the applicable import health standard Dairy Products and Products Containing Dairy Ingredients from Specified Countries DAIEDIIC.SPE:

Part D, Zoosanitary Certificate not required in cases where the assessment has been made that a permit can be issued.

The manufacturer's declaration contains the information verifying that the dairy component of the composite product has been pasteurized, thus confirming that the dairy component of the composite product is not a risk item.

The reason for directing clearance is that the biosecurity risks associated with this CTO direction have been assessed and are managed effectively.

This direction takes effect from the date of signing and continues in effect until amended or revoked.
