 - (d) the acquired animal material or animal product has been rendered or it has been subject to primary processing by an earlier processor in accordance with a registered RMP or RBM.

- Listing of further petfood processors with the Ministry for Primary Industries is required under the Animal Products Regulations 2021. The further petfood processing operation covers the processing of petfood that is **raw meat or other animal material or animal product that results from the death of the source animal** (e.g. red meat, offal, poultry or fish).
- A hand icon is used when you need to make a decision. The question will help you decide whether you need to complete a particular section.
- Throughout this form you will need to tick boxes that look like this: ☐. A checked box indicates a 'yes' answer.
- Send the completed application form together with the fee and any other documentation required (see below) to MPI at the above address. We prefer email files. Processing time is up to 20 working days from the time we determine that your application is complete.
- If there are any changes to the details provided in this application after the application has been submitted, you must promptly inform MPI of the changes in writing.

BMS	means bivalve molluscan shellfish.
Fish	includes all seafood other than bivalve molluscan shellfish.
Ostrich and Emu	For secondary processing ostrich and emu are considered "Red Meat".
Poultry	includes chickens, ducks, geese, turkey, pheasant, quail and guinea fowl. Does not include layer hens.
Red meat	includes except where provided for: meat, offal, blood, bone from the following species: Alpacas/llamas, bobby calves, cattle (including wild, game estate, farmed gone feral), wild chamois, deer (including wild, game estate, farmed gone feral), goats (including wild, game estate, farmed gone feral), wild hares, horses (including mules, donkeys, hinnies and wild horses), pigs (including wild, game estate, farmed gone feral), rabbits (including wild), sheep (including wild, game estate, farmed gone feral), wild thar, wild wallabies, water buffaloes, bison and cattle hybrids, ostrich and emu.

Process operations applicable to various products	
Acidification	Limited to the addition of acids e.g. marinating (where pH is sufficient to preserve the product otherwise marinating (flavouring) should be covered by formulation).
Aseptic processing	Commercial sterilisation of shelf stable product involving aseptic processing.
Drying/reduction of a_w	All processes intended to reduce water activity (a_w) including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - mechanical processes, e.g. concentration, evaporation, intermediate moisture products, using all means e.g. freeze drying, oven drying, vacuum drying, spray drying etc. Examples of products are animal biscuits, dried powders and preserved milks (evaporated milk) and; - use of additives e.g. humectants.
Formulation	Addition of any other ingredients (i.e. most further processors will have this activity), includes coating, assembling, and non-animal ingredient addition – a process that does not have a preservation effect. Where other animal products are added as ingredients only (i.e. are not subject to any other processes prior to mixing or blending). This can also be covered by formulation (e.g. the addition of purchased deer velvet or colostrum for addition to animal products)
In container retorting	Commercial sterilisation of shelf stable product for human or animal consumption includes cans , pouches etc.
Refrigeration	Any operation involving active chilling and/or freezing product with the equipment necessary to be able to undertake this operation (chillers, refrigerators, freezers) Note: chilling and freezing are not identified separately.
Size reduction	Dicing, mincing, milling and grinding.
Smoking	Limited to hot and cold smoking product in a smoke house. Note: addition of smoke flavours is covered by formulation.
Heat Treatment	Cooking and pasteurisation intended to reduce microbiological levels (specified kill) and subsequent cooling. Does not include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - in container retorting and aseptic processing; and - low heat treatment or heat treatment for technological effect e.g. flash frying.
