CTO direction to biosecurity inspectors for the clearance of one dog: Microchip # 0A130C4974

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Lucy Johnston, Acting Manager Animal Imports, Ministry for Primary Industries (under delegated authority), give the following directions for one dog to be given clearance in accordance with the following measures, different from those in the applicable Import Health Standard for Cats and Dogs (CATDOG.GEN 2014):

Equivalence from clauses 1.10 (1)(c)(i) of the IHS: The accession number (R14-023164-3) on the Kansas State Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory report and Phoenix Central Laboratory report link directly to the microchip number of the dog (0A130C4974) and allow full traceability.

The reason for directing clearance is that the biosecurity risks associated with this CTO direction have been assessed and are managed effectively.

This direction takes effect from the date of signing and continues in effect until amended or revoked.
