Biosecurity clearance of non-compliant consignment/s

CTO direction code for recording in Quantum: CTOPlants: 20140032

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I direct that the following measure in relation to the treatment of roses with propiconazole, different to that set out in the *Rosa* schedule of Importation of Nursery Stock standard 155.02.06 (the IHS), may be applied to roses to effectively manage risks.

- *Rosa* whole plants and non-dormant cuttings entering New Zealand without the required Propiconazole treatment may be treated with Propiconazole at an MPI approved treatment facility prior to transfer to the PEQ facility listed on the permit to import.

This direction takes effect from the date of signing, and may apply to multiple consignments of *Rosa* whole plants or non-dormant cuttings from approved countries which are not compliant with the measures required by the IHS. This CTO direction is valid until October 2015 at which stage it must be reviewed, unless it is amended or revoked.
