OMARs with an uncertain status

These OMARs have not been used for a significant period of time. Therefore the requirements may have changed without the Ministry for Primary Industries knowledge.

If an exporter can provide the current import conditions, and the requirements still match, the certificate and the OMARs will be moved back into the published list of export certificates and OMAR's.

1. Statutory authority

Pursuant to section 60 of the Animal Products Act 1999, I notify the following overseas market access requirements, entitled poultry hatching eggs to Tuvalu.

2. Tuvalu Requirements

Poultry hatching eggs exported from New Zealand to Tuvalu must comply with the import regulations of Tuvalu listed in this notice as follows.

- 2.1 The shipper of the hatching eggs must sign a declaration that:
 - 2.1.1 The hatching eggs are from birds which have been tested with negative results by the agglutination test for *Salmonella pullorum* and are therefore free from the disease known as bacilliary white diarrhoea.
 - 2.1.2 The hatching eggs were produced on premises which have been free from infection with *Salmonella pullorum* for at least 6 months preceeding the date of shipment.
- 2.2 The official veterinarian must certify after due enquiry that they have no reason to doubt the shippers declaration.

3. Definitions

For the purposes of this document:

Any term or expression that is defined in the Animal Products Act 1999 and used, but not defined in this document, has the same meaning as in this Act.

Explanatory note

These overseas market access requirements are based on Importation of Animals Regulations, Regulation 13' as required by the import permit from the Tuvalu Ministry of Natural Resources Department of Agriculture dated 9 December 2003.
