## Appendix 1: CTO Direction 20140034 - Dried Tobacco Products

Pursuant to sections 27 and 104 of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, give the following directions for consignments of dried tobacco imported under the following equivalent conditions:

- A permit to import is issued to specify Phosphine fumigated sea containers, containing tobacco for further processing, with yellow sticky traps inside the container and receiving an AP check, is equivalent to the requirement to inspect dried tobacco as per section 2.5 in the IHS *Dried and Preserved Plant Material, and Fresh Plant Material for Testing, Analysis or Research*, and effectively manages the risks identified in the IHS.
- The results of identification of the specimens captured in the yellow sticky traps will be recorded in Quancargo allowing for review when the permit expires.
- Consignments will have to meet all other requirements of the IHS Dried and Preserved Plant Material, and Fresh Plant Material for Testing, Analysis or Research and the IHS Sea Containers.
