



Animal Products (Specifications for Products Intended for Human Consumption) Notice 2013

Date: December 2013

1 Background

Since 2004, 9 amendments had been made to the Animal Products (Specifications for Products Intended for Human Consumption) Notice 2004. To assist stakeholders to identify and apply the requirements of the various notices, a legal consolidation of the principal Notice and each of the amendments was undertaken, producing the Animal Products (Specifications for Products Intended for Human Consumption) Notice 2013.

No other changes have been made to the technical content of the Notice during this consolidation.

2 Cancellation

This Notice revokes and replaces the Animal Products (Specifications for Products Intended for Human Consumption) Notice 2004.

3 Implementation

This Notice will come into effect on 1 February 2014. A transition clause has been included in the Notice to allow the forms in Schedule 5, paragraphs (c) to (h) that were in effect under the 2004 version of the Notice to continue to be used until February 28, 2014. From that date the new forms must be used. The affected forms are:

- Certified Supplier Statement for the Supply of Wild Mammal Material for Human Consumption.
- Certified Supplier Statement for the Supply of Live Possums for Human Consumption.
- Certified Game Estate Supplier Statement for the Supply of Game Estate Mammals for Human Consumption.
- Supplier Statement for the Supply of Poultry for Slaughter for Human Consumption.
- Supplier Statement for the Supply of Farmed Fish for Human Consumption (other than Bivalve Molluscan Shellfish).
- Poison Use Statement.
